Coursework:

CAES IRSP students will enroll as a cohort in approved CAES courses offered fall 2024 and spring 2025. Classes are delivered in-person and include current UGA students. Course selection is limited to CAES courses identified for the Program.

CAES-Ivester Rising Scholars Program (CAES-IRSP)

Funding and Expenses:

Upon approval, Dual Enrollment funds will pay the tuition charges for approved coursework. Students who have exceeded their 30 funded DE hours are eligible to self-pay.

UGA will provide books.

TIMELINE FOR THE CAES Ivester Rising Scholars Program

NOTE: Before May 2024	Must take SAT or ACT and have results sent to UGA.	ACT or SAT scores are required for application by UGA and are minimums set by USG, although they will use a holistic process to evaluate applications.
March 28, 2024	Ivester Rising Scholar Application Due	24-25 Ivester Early College Application Link
April 15, 2024	Applicants notified of Status	All applicants will be notified via email of status; only semifinalists will be invited to complete the UGA Dual Enrollment Application.
May 2024	UGA application deadline for all IRSP semifinalists	Semifinalists are encouraged to work closely with IEC's Ag advisor, Taren.dailey-Rowland@hallco.org and their high school guidance counselor to complete the UGA Dual Enrollment process.
June 2024	Notification of Acceptance Status to IRSP
